The Parish Choir serves as the backbone of the music program at Christ Lutheran. It offers an opportunity to rehearse and perform great sacred choral music in an open, inviting, and meaningful liturgical atmosphere. Our choir enhances the worship of our church through hymn leadership, choral anthems, and special programs. Membership is comprised of people of diverse backgrounds, ages, and abilities who enjoy getting together on a weekly basis for great music, hard work, fun and fellowship.

The Parish Choir provides the primary musical leadership for the Sunday Holy Eucharist at either 9:00 or 11:00 AM (depending on the church rotation schedule) and other Holy Day services. Our repertoire draws from a broad range of musical periods and styles, including plainchant, 16th century anthems and motets, works of the great 18th and 19th century masters, as well as contemporary compositions.
